

Crossover between HE and NHS licensing arrangements

CLA has granted separate licences to Higher Education institutions (HEIs) and to the National Health Service (NHS) in England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland to cover photocopying and scanning.

While it is recognised that there is a significant degree of co-operation, collaboration and partnership between HEIs and NHS Trusts – especially in respect of Teaching Hospitals, joint library facilities and staff engaged in delivering teaching and / or participating in courses of study in one or both sectors – the principles underpinning the making of licensed copies are that:

- copies made by, for, or on behalf of staff and students of a university or College of Higher Education are subject to the terms of the HE Licence
- copies made by, for or on behalf of staff employed by the NHS are subject to the terms and conditions of the NHS Licence
- all copying activity should retain an intimate link between the collection of printed books, journals and magazines owned by the respective HEI or NHS Trust and its delivery to an authorised user contracted to / enrolled with that HEI or contracted to that NHS Trust
